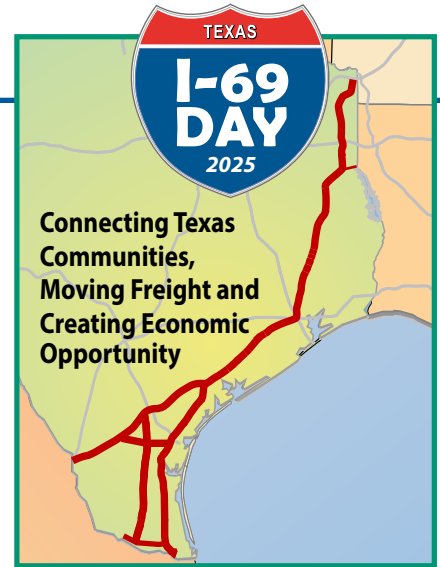


I-69 Austin Day 2025 - Feb. 27th
